All insurances will be billed with insurance information documented on the attached vaccine consent form. If no insurance or underinsured the cost of vaccine is reasonable.

In order for the vaccines to be given, The Mahoning County District Board of Health will require the following paperwork:

1. The Vaccine Consent Forms filled out by parents and/or guardians
2. The Screening Questionnaire for the Child and Teen Immunization completed and signed at the bottom of the page in the two different locations
3. The Vaccine Information Statement (VIS) on the Tdap and Menactra for parents/guardians educational purpose about the vaccines

In addition to the paperwork the following is also needed:

4. A copy of the parent's driver license
5. A copy of the insurance card- front and back
6. A copy of the child's immunization (shot) record

All information must be returned to the clinic by April 26 before vaccines can be administered. Parents are not required to be present as long as all information is completed, signed, and returned.

We are providing you this immunization clinic now so that your child will be ready to start school on the first day of the new school year which is August 28, 2017. **The State of Ohio requires that students be excluded from school, if verification of the two vaccines is not received by the 15th day (September 20, 2017) of the new school year.**
