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Dear Falcon Families:

First of all, the 3rd nine week grading period is still ending this coming Friday, March 27th. There is no shortening this nine weeks. The order from the health department to "shelter in place" starting tomorrow at midnight hasn't really changed too much for us.

We ask students/parents to submit any completed assignments electronically when at all possible. Those assignments completed that can be captured by sending a photo or scanned PDF of the file is preferred. We would like to minimize the transfer of paper products between people during this stay at home order.

Students who are completing paper packets and are able to photograph their work should email it to their teacher no later than Friday, March 27 at 3:30 pm. If this is not possible, students/parents can drop off the paper packets in bins that are located outside the school office of each building on March 25-27 from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm.

For students who cannot access online work, paper packets must be requested by emailing their lead principal. Packet pick-up will take place in the parking lot between AES and AIS for grades K-5 and in the front loop of AMS for grades 6-8. Any questions regarding grading period or assignments should be directed to your lead principal at your child's building.

Important dates to remember:

- Friday, March 27th- End of third nine weeks at 3:00 p.m.
- Materials given for the week of March 30- April 3- Due April 20 at 12:00 p.m.
- On April 20 and 21 new packets will be distributed in parking lots and roundabouts.
