Dear Parent or Guardian:

The primary responsibility of the Austintown Transportation Department is the safe and effective transportation of the students to and from school. It is the privilege of every student that meets transportation guidelines to receive transportation services. Parents/Guardians have the responsibility to ensure students follow rules, regulations, and policies that have been established by the Board of Education.

Among those responsibilities is that parents/guardians, particularly of primary, preschool, and disability students, are home to meet their children at the end of the school day. Preschool and Elementary students will not intentionally be left at a residence at which an authorized person is not present. It is the <u>parents'</u> responsibility to have an emergency plan in place. It is a good idea to make arrangements with a neighbor, relative, or friend.

Parents who are unable to wait outside need to let the driver know that they are home by possibly leaving a porch light on, or a garage door open. Parents need to communicate to the transportation department, in writing, as to what their accommodations are.

On the occasion, when there is not an authorized person available to meet your child, attempts will be made to contact a parent or emergency person. If we can not make immediate contact, students will be returned to the appropriate school. Children who are repeatedly returned, because there is no adult available, may be suspended from transportation.
